

Deercreek Dam Days Queen

- 1. The Queen are to be visible during the remaining of our festival. The Queen is expected to ride on the festival float for the remaining Deercreek Dam Days parades. If you are not able to please notify the Royalty Coordinator as soon as possible.
- 2. The Queen must never have been married at the time of judging and must remain single during the reign.
- 3. If the Queen gets married, become pregnant or involved in any immoral situations/scandal during your reign, your title will be immediately relinquished.
- 4. If the Queen is 18 and has a smoking habit, this must be told to the Royalty Coordinator immediately after winning the title. Smoking is not allowed during Deercreek Dam Days or hosting festivals.
- 5. The Queen is expected to attend at least 15 festivals during her reign. There will be 5 mandatory festivals that the queen must attend. If the Queen is unable to attend the directors may at their willing replace one of the mandatory with another local festival. The Queen is always free at all luncheons and we will pay for ONE chaperon luncheon cost. If under 18 must be with a chaperon.

Mandatory Festivals: Commercial Point Homecoming, Ashville 4th of July, Pumpkin Show, Wild Turkey Festival, and the Feast of the Flowering Moon.

- 6. The Queen will need to keep in touch with the Coordinator when traveling and during their reign to see how things are going with traveling to festivals and such.
- 7. No PDA of any kind is permitted. You are not permitted to have your boyfriend with you while in your sash and crown.
- 8. If the Queen wants to attend a luncheon at a hosting festival, you will need to notify the Royalty Coordinator by

the deadline date and the cost of the luncheon and trip is at the cost of you and your chaperone. You are **NOT** permitted to attend a luncheon on your own. If this happens you will get a warning, the 2nd time you will be suspended from the next allowed festival, the 3rd time you will be suspended for the rest of your reign.

- 9. If you have committed to a festival or a luncheon and are unable to attend, you need to notify the Royalty Coordinator immediately and a legitimate excuse must be given. If this happens more than once, the Royalty Coordinator will determine if you are able to attend other festivals or luncheons.
- 10. If the Royalty Coordinator or a member of the Deercreek Dam Days committee is notified by a hosting festival of any problems that have occurred with the Queen or a court member, the Royalty Coordinator will be in contact with you and the incident will be discussed and if the situation warrants, negative consequences could occur including relinquishing your title and crown.
- 11. Must wear the crown they receive at crowning. If your crown/tiara is damaged/lost, it must be replaced with the identical one at the cost of royalty member. Damaged items may not be worn.
- 12. Scholarship: The queen after serving her full reign (1 year) in good standing (has fulfilled all the rules and regulations in this article and has not been dismissed/suspended for any unforeseen circumstances by the committee or directors) she will receive her check in the full amount (\$500.00).
- 13. Age: Contestants will compete in their age division according to their age on May 10th.

It is the responsibility of the Queen and her parents or guardian to read and understand all the rules set forth in this contract. By signing this contract, you are agreeing to abide by all rules and regulations as stated for the Royalty reign.
